About: The *Lost Sea Expedition* is a TV series about Bernie Harberts' 14 month, 2,500 mile mule voyage across America.

Length: 4 segments (segment length 26:46)

Release: 2017

Route: Saskatchewan, Canada to Fort Hancock, Texas via 10 states.

Length: 14 months

Mission: to learn more about the people, animals, culture and marine fossils of the Great Plains.

Filming: Bernie and his mule traveled without a film crew, support team or sponsor. He filmed the voyage with the gear he carried in his wagon.

Voyage funding: Bernie covered travel expenses by selling his books and accepting gifts from folks met along the way.

Series funding: Bernie is raising funds from individual and corporate sources to bring the TV series to Public Television

About Bernie: Author and film maker. Bernie is the first person to host, film, direct, produce, edit and fund raise a TV series about a solo wagon voyage across America. He has sailed alone around the world, pedaled around Tasmania on a \$10 bike, crossed Newfoundland on a mule, sailed from the Falkland Islands to South Georgia (off Antarctica) and on to South Africa and traveled across America by mule – twice.
